

CALL FOR BIDS
CITY OF TOPPENISH
WEST 2ND AVENUE SEWER REPLACEMENT

Sealed Proposals will be received by the undersigned at the City of Toppenish, 21 W. First Avenue, Toppenish, Washington 98948 up to 10:00 A.M.; local time on Tuesday, April 18, 2017, for furnishing the necessary labor, materials, equipment, tools, and guarantees thereof to construct West 2nd Avenue Sewer Replacement.

This contract provides for the construction of approximately 1,250 feet of 18-inch PVC sanitary sewer main by open excavation, approximately 150 feet of 10-inch HDPE sanitary sewer main by trenchless pipe bursting, approximately 25 feet of 8-inch HDPE sanitary sewer forcemain by open excavation, manholes, side sewer connection and re-connection, surface restoration and other work all in accordance with the attached Contract Plans, these Special Provisions and the Standard Specifications.

The Work shall be substantially complete within 20 working days after the commencement date stated in the Notice to Proceed. All bidding and construction is to be performed in compliance with the Contract Provisions and Contract Plans for this project and any addenda issued thereto that are on file at the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, Toppenish, Washington.

The Proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud shortly after the time and date stated above. Proposals are to be submitted only on the form provided with the Contract Provisions. All Proposals must be accompanied by a certified check, cashiers check, money order, or bid bond payable to the "City of Toppenish" and in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount bid.

Contract Provisions and Contract Plans may be *examined* at the office of the City of Toppenish, or the office of the Project Engineer, Gray & Osborne, Inc. Contract Provisions and Contract Plans for this project are available free-of-charge at the following website: "<http://gobids.grayandosborne.com>". Bidders are encouraged to "Register" as a planholder in order to receive automatic email notification of applicable addenda and to be placed on the "Planholder List". For assistance, please call (509) 453-4833. Contract questions shall be directed only to the office of the Project Engineer.

All work on the project shall be subject to the higher of the State or Federal wage rates. Where federal wage rates apply, the successful bidder will be required to conform to the wage requirements prescribed by the federal Davis-Bacon and Related Acts which requires that all laborers and mechanics employed by contractors and subcontractors performing on contracts funded in whole or in part by SRF appropriations in excess of

\$2000 pay their laborers and mechanics not less than the prevailing wage rates and fringe benefits, as determined by the Secretary of Labor, for corresponding classes of laborers and mechanics employed on similar projects in the area.

Financing of the Project has been provided the City of Toppenish, Washington and the Washington State Department of Ecology. Neither the State of Washington nor any of its departments or employees are, or shall be, a party to this Contract or any subcontract resulting from this solicitation for bids. The City expressly reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals and to waive minor irregularities or informalities and to Award the Project to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder as it best serves the interests of the City.
