

#### **Discussion:**

The City contracts for corrections/detention services through an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) with the City of Sunnyside. Sunnyside has prepared and presented Addendum 4 to the original contract for the purpose of increasing the per day rate from \$60.00 to \$63.00. The rate increase would become effective once the ILA has been endorsed by both parties. If the City Council approves Addendum #4, the effective date would be January 23, 2024.

Based on the increasing costs of goods and services, as well as increased personnel costs, staff recommends the City Council approve the proposed Resolution 2024-03.

**Fiscal Impact:** The proposed rate increase was included in the 2024 Budget.

Recommendation: Approve Resolution 2024-03, authorizing the City Manager to sign Addendum 4 to the

Interlocal Agreement with the City of Sunnyside for the housing of inmates.

# A RESOLUTION APPROVING ADDENDUM 4 TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON AND THE CITY OF TOPPENISH, WASHINGTON, FOR THE HOUSING OF INMATES

WHEREAS, Chapter 39.34.180 of the Revised Code of Washington requires that the City is responsible for the incarceration of misdemeanor and gross misdemeanor offences committed by adults in the City's jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS, the Toppenish City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the community to contract for the housing of Toppenish inmates, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 39.34 of the Revised Code of Washington provides for interlocal cooperation between governmental agencies, and

WHEREAS, the city of Toppenish and its Police Department wish to utilize the Sunnyside Jail facilities for the custody of prisoners arrested by the Toppenish Police Department, and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside is willing to continue to make its jail facilities available for use by the Toppenish Police Department with a rate increase of \$3.00 per day per inmate when Toppenish provides all transportation needs and for inmates staying longer than seven days in the jail facility,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPPENISH, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

The Addendum 4 to Interlocal Agreement between the City of Sunnyside, Washington and the City of Toppenish, Washington for the housing of inmates is approved and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute said agreement on behalf of the City.

This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and signatures hereto.

## INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON AND THE CITY OF TOPPENISH, WASHINGTON, FOR THE HOUSING OF INMATES ADDENDUM 4

THIS ADDENDUM TO OUR INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT (hereinafter referred to as "Agreement") is made and entered into by and between the City of Sunnyside, Washington and the City of Toppenish, Washington;

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside and the City of Toppenish already have an Agreement for the housing of inmates;

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside desires to modify this Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, condition and promises contained herein, the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

SECTION 6(a) COMPENSATION shall be repealed and replaced with:

(a) Rates. Sunnyside agrees to accept and house City of Toppenish inmates for compensation per inmate at the rate of \$63.00 per day. The date of booking into the Sunnyside Jail of any City of Toppenish inmate shall be charged a minimum of a full daily rate per inmate regardless of the time of booking within a 24 hour period. The date of release from the Sunnyside Jail and/or returned to City of Toppenish, regardless of the time frame within a 24 hour day shall not constitute a charge by the City of Sunnyside against City of Toppenish.

This Agreement shall be effective from January 1, 2024 or once fully endorsed by both parties, whichever is latter.

The remainder of the original Agreement remains unchanged.
