

1 INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR ADMINISTRATION OF
2 FINANCES FOR CABLE TV FRANCHISES

3 THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 13th day of November,
4 1984, by and between the City of Toppenish, Washington, (hereinafter
5 referred to as Toppenish), the City of Wapato, Washington (hereinafter
6 referred to as Wapato), the City of Zillah, Washington, (hereinafter
7 referred to as Zillah), and the Town of Granger, Washington (hereinafter
8 referred to as Granger), each being a municipal corporation pursuant
9 to the laws of the State of Washington;

10 WITNESSETH:

11 WHEREAS, Toppenish, Wapato, Zillah and Granger have adopted a CATV
12 Franchise Ordinance within their respective jurisdictions; and

13 WHEREAS, said CATV ordinance provides for the payment of franchise
14 fees to each city and town being a party this agreement, in an amount
15 equal to 5% of the cable television company's gross revenues from all
16 sources attributable to the operations of the cable television company
17 within the confines of each respective jurisdiction, with payments being
18 made on a quarterly basis; and,

19 WHEREAS, said ordinance further provides that the franchise fees
20 paid by the cable television company shall be available to administer
21 the franchise granted by said ordinance, as well as to further the
22 development of public and community uses of cable television within each
23 of the respective jurisdictions; and

24 WHEREAS, in order to provide for a cooperative and efficient
25 administration of the cable television franchise among the various
26 jurisdictions, the parties hereto desire to consolidate the administrative
27 functions and payment of the costs of administration of the cable
28 television franchise.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants, conditions
and benefits to be derived herefrom, the parties hereto mutually agree
as follows: -

1. That the City of Toppenish shall provide financial management
services to the Cable Regulation Board and to the parties hereto, in
the administration of the franchise fees and other funds received by

1 the Cable Regulation Board, pursuant to the Cable Regulation Budget as
2 adopted by the Cable Regulation Board and approved by the parties hereto.

3 2. That the franchise fees received by the jurisdictions of Wapato,
4 Zillah, Toppenish and Granger shall be paid to the Cable Television Fund
5 125 of the City of Toppenish.

6 3. That out of said franchise fees and other funds, the Cable
7 Communications Officer shall pay the costs, debts and expenses incurred
8 in the administration of the Cable Television Franchise and local access,
as approved by the Cable Regulation Board.

9 4. That a copy of this agreement shall be filed with each city
10 clerk of the respective jurisdictions and with the Yakima County Auditor
11 and with the Secretary of State as required by Section 39.34.040 of the
Revised Code of Washington.

12 5. That the parties hereto are equal opportunity employers.


