CALL TO ORDER

Mayor C. Jiménez called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL

Present: Mayor Clara Jiménez and Councilmembers Mark Oaks, Derald Ortloff, Gabriel Piñon, Blaine Thorington and Angelica Walle.

Excused Absence: Councilmember J. Eligio Jiménez.

Staff Present: City Manager Lance Hoyt (CM Hoyt), Public Works Superintendent Rocky Wallace and Executive Assistant/Deputy City Clerk Heidi Riojas.

Councilmember Ortloff moved, seconded by Councilmember Walle to excuse Councilmember J. Jiménez from the May 1, 2017 Study Session. Motion carried unanimously.

**DISCUSSION REGARDING SIX-YEAR TRANSPORTATION (STREET)
IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

CM Hoyt updated Council on the proposed Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) noting the State requires each City and County to annually update their TIP by June of each year and file a copy of the adopted TIP with the Washington State Department of Transportation by June 30th of each year; and that the update outlines the City's plan for street projects for the next six years. CM Hoyt further noted the TIP outlines each of the proposed project's estimates for project objectives, costs and secured funding sources, as well as the anticipated starting and completion dates. CM Hoyt noted the projects included in the proposed Six-Year TIP for 2018-2023 are Lincoln/Date/Beech Improvements Phase 2, Jackson Street Extension Improvements, Second Avenue Improvements (South Elm to Bolin), South Juniper Street and Jackson Street Improvements, and the Pedestrian Mural Attraction Sidewalk Improvements.

Councilmember Thorington moved, seconded by Councilmember Ortloff to pre-approve advertising for the Public Hearing on May 22, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.
